Statement

My last lecture (2006), *"From Plato Platini to Platinette to genetically modified planning"*, to students of architecture was delivered in Lisbon University four years after I had left my tenure position at Liverpool University to practice full time in Italy. Liverpool had been my home since I began to study architecture after Italian preparatory school education and military obligatory service in the army. Practical training was undertaken with Building Design Partnership and Nicholas Grimshaw and Partners. Academic and practice research investigation focused into *"urban out of hours"* and the *"salubrious and healthy city"*. Commissions in the studio have been developed through the idea of *slow architecture* like the slow food movement. Simply considering architecture not as a style but an outcome of environmental and social issues, arts and techniques, local and available materials, limited financial resources, renewable energy and artistic celebration.

qarchlab is a laboratory that besides architecture deals with art, music, poetry, and environmental issues. On www.qarchlab.it architecture is described with my poetry, artwork and published essays.

Method

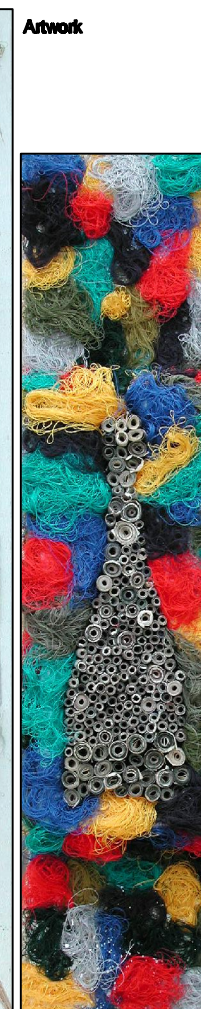
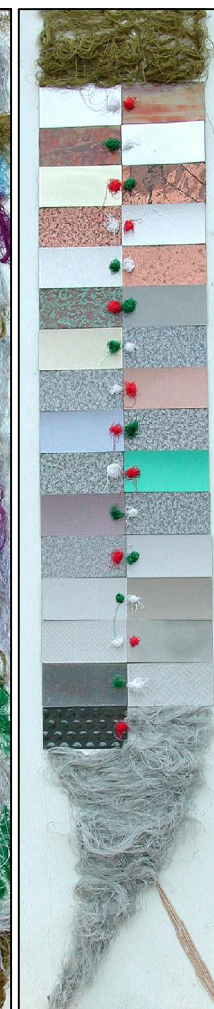
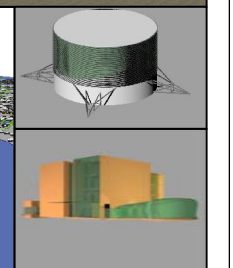
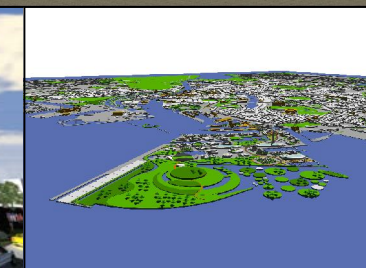
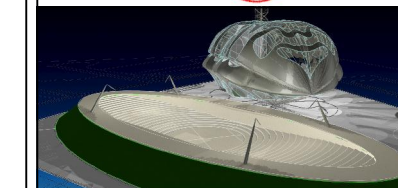
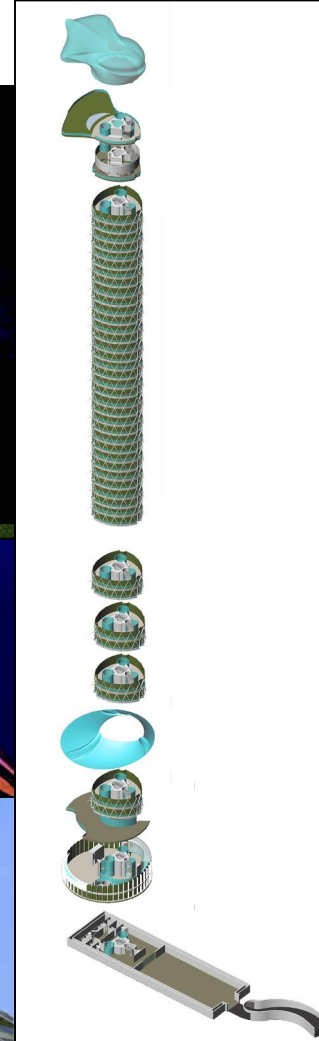
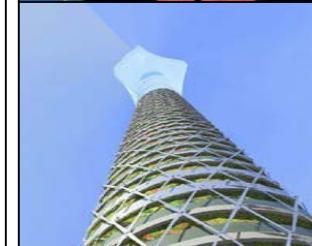
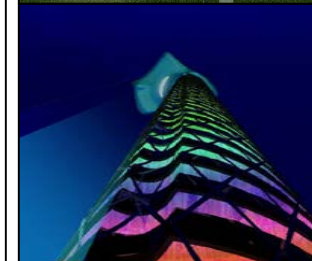
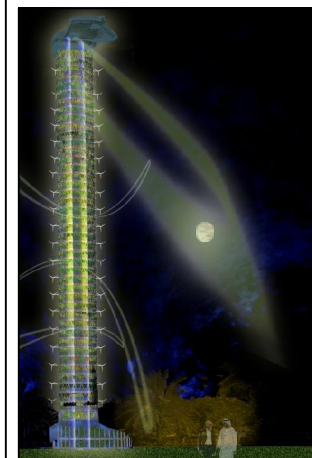
Qarchlab design process, whatever a small or large project flows through the following interactive paths: *intuition, research, analysis, choice and celebration*. The method integrates a continuous dialogue with consultants, engineers, specialists, the client, his people, their expertise, ideals, goals, resources, and the institutions. This approach allows architecture to display its artistic technical process integrating users needs. I draw, either freehand or with the computer, in order to follow all design stages and also follow the works on site. In the event we were chosen to participate to the competition we would make the necessary arrangements to group with a team of Melbourne based consultants and if winners, and in accordance with University wishes, qarchlab would join with a Melbourne based architect's practice to support production and execution of the project. Finally the project could be devised as a live experience for architecture students in the forms that safety on site or potential practical training would allow.
